

Single Sign-On for ALL Microsoft and Google Services

Single sign-on is now set up on all the Chromebooks. In order to log into the Chromebooks, all users will sign on with their district provided Usernames and Passwords (the same you use for your district workstations). Upon logging into the Chromebook you will have access to ALL Google and Microsoft services without signing in again, including outlook online as well as Google drive, calendar, etc. For most of our teachers, this will work the same as it has, with the exception of only one password to remember for both Google and Microsoft services.

This will also affect the student accounts as well. If the students are in K-3 they will continue to use the generic account for the Chromebooks that they have used up until this point. 4-12 students have their own district provided credentials and will need to log in using their accounts. Most of the student accounts should be available now (as of 8-29-17), but there are still some accounts being added. Over the course of the next few days/weeks, these remaining accounts should be created and synchronized with Google services. Please make certain all students are using their ID's to do work on Chromebook, unless their account is not available yet, or are in K-3.
