Mission of Hope Scholarship Program Criteria & Info - <u>For Scholarship Applicants</u>

Who can become a Mission of Hope Scholar?

- Seniors at one of the 13 High Schools we serve
- Have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Have good character qualities and participates in school activities
- Show financial need
- Have some work experience
- Applying at a two-year, four-year or vocational/technical school

To become a Mission of Hope Scholar, you must...

- Get a copy of the application from your Guidance Counselor
- Complete the application
- Include a hand written letter, <u>in black ink</u>, making a request for the Scholarship and <u>explaining the need for financial assistance</u>; along with other personal information and background, work experience and future education and life goals.
- Include two Letters of Recommendation from the Principal, Guidance Counselor and/or teacher.
- Include School Transcript and ACT Scores
- Return Application and other requested documents to the Guidance Counselor
- Have Guidance Counselor mail applications to MOH postmarked no later than Weds., March 4.
- Be available for a Skype interview at their high school by the Scholarship Committee
- The selected MOH Scholar return the 'Contact Information' form and 'Initial Scholarship Agreement' form before their High School graduation.
- Attend <u>mandatory</u> Scholars' Dinner in July, 2020.

How does the Scholarship work?

- \$2,500 annually pro-rated base on \$1,250 per semester* (See below about Scholars receiving TN Promise)
- Money is paid directly to the college
- Funding begins in the fall semester following high school graduation
- Scholarships are for one year. It is the desire, funds permitting, that the scholarship will be available for an additional year. If funds do permit, current Scholars must meet all qualifications in order to continue as a Mission of Hope Scholar.
- Scholars will also be paired with a Mission of Hope Mentor to help and encourage them.

All Mission of Hope Scholars must...

- Maintain a minimum of 12 Credit Hours per semester and a minimum 2.5 GPA per semester
- Provide Mission of Hope a transcript (an unofficial copy is fine) or screenshot of your grades immediately
 upon receiving them at the end of each semester. Transcript/Screenshot must show course name, grades
 & credit hours and semester GPA. The next semester check will not be sent until grades are received.
- Respond in a timely manner to any correspondence from the Mission of Hope office and/or their Mentor

You will be ineligible for a Scholarship if you fail to maintain any of the above requirements.

*If the selected Tennessee Scholar is attending a 2-yr community college and receives the Tennessee Promise Scholarship as well, the student will receive a portion (\$750 per semester) from the MOH to cover books and fees (costs not covered by Tennessee Promise). As you are aware, the full value of our Scholarship is \$2,500/year. Therefore, the balance of the remaining Scholarship (\$500 per semester), will be banked by the MOH in that students name, to be used towards pursuing a 4-yr degree should the student decide to continue their education beyond the 2-yr community college. (Please note: this money will only be banked for up to 3 years post High School graduation. At that time, if the student has chosen to not continue on with a 4-yr college/university, that money will roll back into the MOH Scholarship Fund to support other students in the future.)
